Three universities gain RESEARCH Infosource's designation of *Research University of the Year* by university type for their outstanding performance on a balanced set of input and output measures for FY2003. These full-service universities demonstrated superior achievement both in earning research income and in publishing research in leading Canadian and international journals.
